# PART V, LINE 4 - INTENDED USES FOR ENDOWMENT FUNDS

THERE ARE TWO FUNDS TREATED AS ENDOWMENT FUNDS. THE SUZANNE LYSANDROU-DEPAOLIS VASCULITIS EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH ENDOWMENT WAS ESTABLISHED TO SUPPORT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, RESOURCES, AND TRAINING FOR VASCULITIS PATIENTS AND MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS. THE ENDOWMENT WILL CEASE ON DECEMBER 13, 2055, AFTER WHICH THE BALANCE WILL BE SPENT DOWN IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS. THE VASCULITIS FOUNDATION BOARD HAS DESIGNATED CERTAIN FUNDS, TO BE TREATED SIMILARLY TO AN ENDOWMENT, TO GENERATE A LONG-TERM TOTAL RATE OF RETURN THAT WILL INCREASE THE VALUE OF THE ASSETS AND PROVIDE A LONG TERM RESERVE FUND FOR THE ORGANIZATION.

THE FOUNDATION QUALIFIES AS TAX EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.
